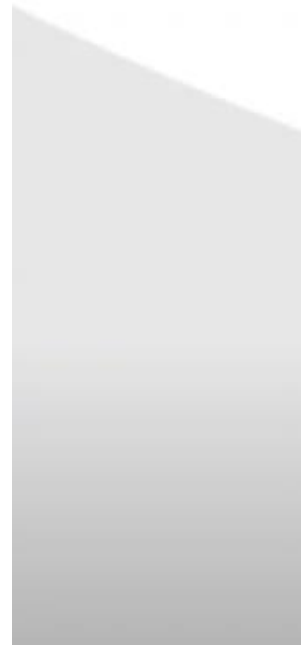
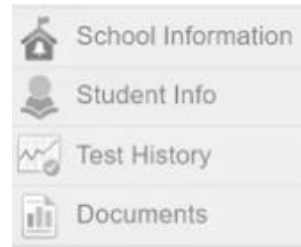

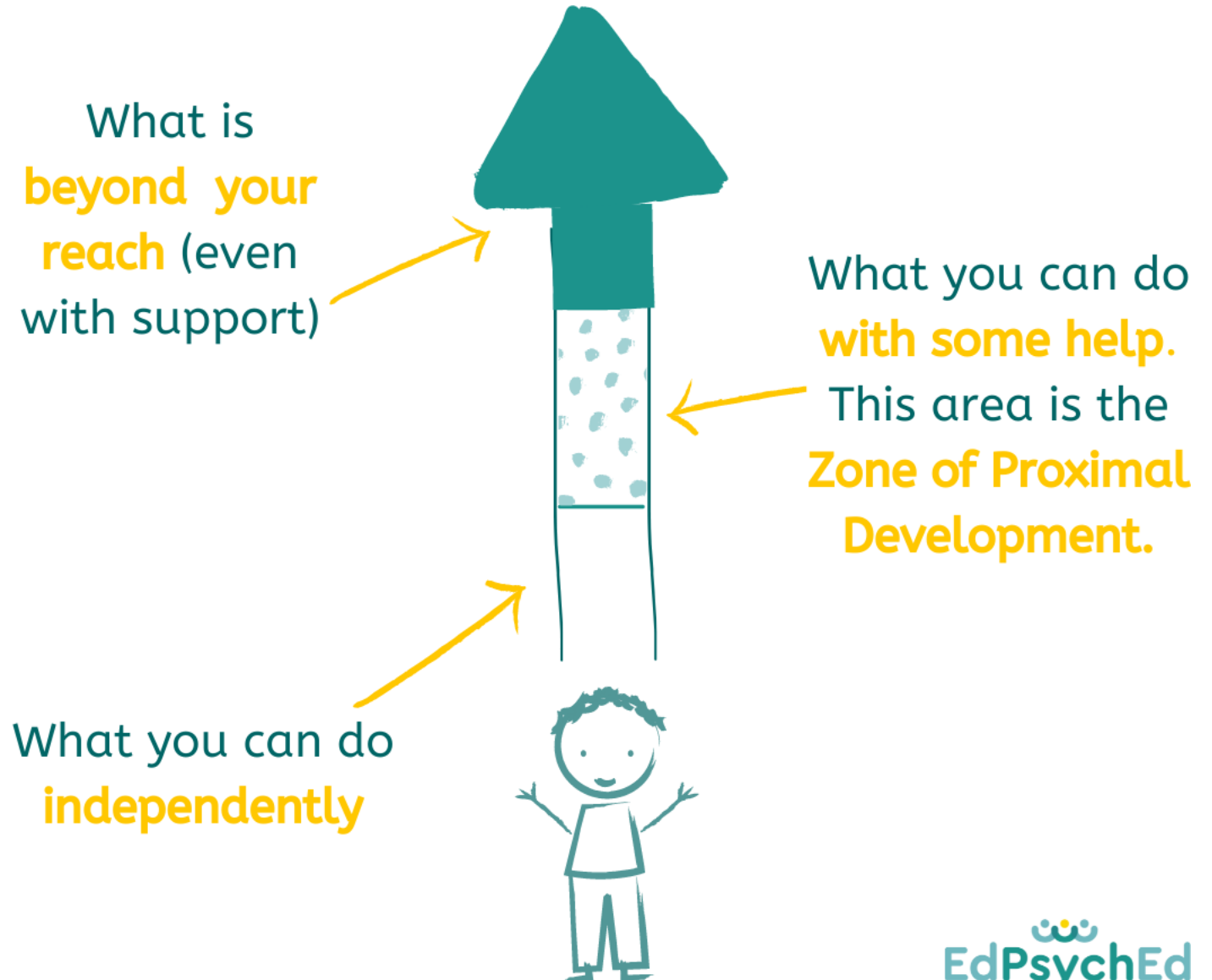

What is known


Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD): what is too difficult for learner to accomplish independently, but could be done with guidance from a More Knowledgeable Other (MKO)

What is not known

Scaffolding

- What if I show you how to do a problem and then we work on this together?
- Can you show me how you start this problem?
- You are doing great, learning is hard and can be frustrating.
- You've gotten so much better/faster/stronger in this since last month.
- Have you tried _____? I can show you how I do it.
